ENTRY:

An Entry consists of, up to and including, four (4) images entered by a single entrant into the same Section. An entrant may only enter a specific Section once. Entrants may not enter identical or similar images into the same section or different sections of the same exhibition. Similar is defined as almost identical in subject, composition, props, lighting or technique so that a reasonable person viewing the entries together would decide the entrant has duplicated the previous image except for minor changes.

SUBMISSION OF WORKS

ONLINE ENTRY FORM

All images should be uploaded through website software only.

Authors must fill out an Online Entry Form on the official website and submit entries online.

Digital entries on CD via postal mail will not be accepted. If you have trouble submitting your digital images on-line, please contact the Chairman by going to the Exhibition Web Site and clicking on Contact Chairman to resolve.

SIZE LIMITS, FILE DIMENSIONS & FILE FORMAT:

Photos must be in jpeg format.

Dimensions:

Maximum image width (For horizontal image) is 1920 pixels.

Maximum image height (For vertical image) is 1080 pixels.

Image resolution must be 300 dpi.

File size is maximum 2 MB.

The entry software will reject images that are larger than the above limits in either dimension even if it is only 1 pixel off. The exhibition will not resize any images. The maximum horizontal and vertical dimensions cannot be swapped. If you rotate your image to make it fit the limits, the exhibition will not rotate it to the proper position for judging.

Use the maximum quality for each of your .jpg images that do not result in a file size larger than 2 Mb.

FILE NAMING

Except for the restriction to use only English alphabet (a-z), no other requirements (do not use special characters) for file names; file name should be the way authors want it to appear in the catalogue (title name).

Each image must have a unique title.

JUDGING METHOD

Judging is to take place remotely (online) by each jury member. Distribution of images shall be in the same round order as submitted by the entrant, but they shall not appear to the judges' consecutively. Remote judging will take place and all judges shall use their own Color calibrated equipment capable of displaying submitted images at 100% of their resolution. The images will not be enlarged beyond their native resolution.

Online Judging will be done by using Computer Monitors & Laptops. The equipment should display 24-bit color (8 bits per channel) or better.

DATA PROTECTION

By entering this exhibition, you are explicitly consenting to the personal details you have supplied, including physical addresses, email addresses, being held, processed and used by the exhibition organizers for purposes associated with this exhibition. You also explicitly consent to such information being sent to organizations that have accorded official recognition, patronage or accreditation to this exhibition. You acknowledge, agree and accept that by entering this exhibition, your participation status which includes your first and last name, name of the country used during registration at the exhibition, number of sections entered and number of photos entered in those sections will be made public in a published status list and that the results of your entry shall be made public in exhibition gallery, exhibition catalogue. SECTION DEFINITIONS

PID Colour

The subject matter is unrestricted for PID images in separate colour and monochrome section. There may be a theme specified for some PID Salons and the exhibition's definition of the theme should be consulted with the organizer.

In accordance with Para II.8 E of FIAP DOC 040/2023 E "Pictures created by artificial intelligence are not allowed in this salon! All parts of the image have to be photographed by the author who is holding the copyright of all works submitted. Offenders will be sanctioned for life!"

All elements of the image must have been shot by the author. All parts of the image including graphics have to be photographed by the author holding copyright of his submitted works. Use of some filters available on net is permissible.

Same images either colour or mono in two different sections of the same Salon will result in disqualification for both the images.

Monochrome Definition

An image is considered to be Monochrome only if it gives the impression of having no colour (i.e. contains only shades of grey which can include pure black and pure white) OR it gives the impression of being a greyscale image that has been toned in one colour across the entire image. (For example, by Sepia, red, gold, etc.)

PSA/FIAP Nature Division (ND) Guidelines

Summary: Nature photography truthfully documents nature stories, both over water and underwater, while maintaining high ethical and technical standards. The 2024 rule allowing **human-made** elements when "necessary to the nature story" has been replaced with three specific categories: integral story elements, small unavoidable background features, and scientific equipment on animals. Attracting subjects with food or sound is prohibited (unaddressed prior to 2025), though incidental photography during hardship feeding remains acceptable. Zoo photography must now be at accredited facilities following best practices, and includes rescue centres and ethical farms. Images eligible for a Wildlife Award or entered in a ND Wildlife theme must follow all Nature rules with additional restrictions: all animals must be living freely in their natural habitat without human control or captivity, botanical subjects cannot be removed from their environment, and no staging is permitted for photography purposes. Readers are reminded that Wildlife photography is restricted to natural habitats only, removing the 2024 allowance for *adopted habitats*. Nature photography does not include anthropology and archaeology.

People Definition (Colour / Monochrome)

Focuses on capturing the likeness, personality, and emotions of individuals or groups of people, festivals with crowd, people activities on street, working environment. The primary objective of people photography is to portray the subjects in a visually appealing and authentic manner, often emphasizing their facial expressions, body language, and overall demeanour. It can encompass a wide range of styles and approaches, including formal studio portraits, candid shots, environmental portraits (where subjects are photographed in their natural surroundings), and lifestyle portraits (capturing people in everyday activities). The photographer aims to convey the subject's character, mood, and narrative through careful composition, lighting, and posing. It involves a strong connection between the photographer and the subjects, as the photographer strives to elicit genuine expressions and emotions, creating images that tell a story or evoke an emotional response from viewers.
